

Dear Passenger!

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that in implementation of the COVID-19 protective measures issued by the Federal Government, as of the entry into force of the respective regulation, the transport ticket entitles the passenger to use the cable car system only in connection with a valid proof of a low epidemiological risk in accordance with the respective regulation (vaccinated, recovered or tested) to be provided by the passenger.

In the event that the term of the transportation ticket (annual pass, season pass, weekly pass, etc..) extends beyond the period of validity of this proof, it is the sole responsibility of the passenger to extend this proof in due time before its expiration and to present it for inspection.

In the case of a transferable card, or in the case of purchase for third parties, this card may only be given to persons who have the required valid proof of low epidemiological risk at the time of use.

If a passenger is unable or unwilling to comply with officially required COVID-19 protective measures, the operator of the facility is obligated to refuse transportation. No claim for a (pro-rata) refund can be made in such cases.

By completing the online order for the season ticket for the Bad Kleinkirchheim ski area, the passenger confirms,

- that he/she has taken note of the above reference to the COVID-19 regulations concerning cable car and ski operation for 2021/22,
- that he/she is aware that he/she is obliged to comply with the applicable legal/official requirements for the use of the purchased season or annual ticket and that the use of the ticket may be restricted, reduced or not possible at all during certain periods.
- that, in the case that the card is passed on, he/she checks whether the person concerned has the required valid proof of a low epidemiological risk at the time of use.
